Internal Operational Regulations of the Joint Usage/Research Center for Radiation Disaster Medical Science

**(Intent)**

ARTICLE 1:

These Internal Operational Regulations stipulate the necessary items with regard to the operation and other aspects of the Joint Usage/Research Center for Radiation Disaster Medical Science (hereinafter referred to as the “RESEARCH CENTER”) which were established pursuant to the provisions of Article 143-3, Paragraph 2 of the Enforcement Regulations for the School Education Law.

**(Aim)**

ARTICLE 2:

The aim of the RESEARCH CENTER is to contribute to the enrichment and development of research into radiation disasters and medical science, based on network-type coordination and cooperation among Hiroshima University, Nagasaki University, and Fukushima Medical University (hereinafter “member universities”).

**(Composition)**

ARTICLE 3:

The RESEARCH CENTER is composed of the following organizations:

- The Research Institute for Radiation Biology and Medicine at Hiroshima University;
- The Atomic Bomb Disease Institute at Nagasaki University;
- The Fukushima Global Medical Science Center at Fukushima Medical University.

**(Center Headquarters)**

ARTICLE 4:

The Center Headquarters for the RESEARCH CENTER shall be located at the Research Institute for Radiation Biology and Medicine at Hiroshima University.

**(Director of the Center Headquarters and Deputy Director of the Center Headquarters)**

ARTICLE 5:

The Director of the Center Headquarters and Deputy Director of the Center Headquarters will be stationed at the Center Headquarters.

2. The Head of the Research Institute for Radiation Biology and Medicine at Hiroshima University shall serve as the Director of the Center Headquarters.
3. The Head of the Atomic Bomb Disease Institute at Nagasaki University (first in rank) and the Head of the Fukushima Global Medical Science Center at Fukushima Medical University (second in rank) shall serve as the Deputy Directors of the Center Headquarters.
4. The Deputy Directors of the Center Headquarters will assist the Director of the Center Headquarters and, in the event the Director of the Center Headquarters becomes incapacitated, will (in order of rank) take over his/her duties in their stead.

**(Center Headquarters Council)**

ARTICLE 6:

The Headquarters Council for the Joint Usage/Research Center for Radiation Disaster Medical Science (hereinafter referred to as the "CENTER HEADQUARTERS COUNCIL") will be established in the RESEARCH CENTER.

2. Items necessary for the CENTER HEADQUARTERS COUNCIL will be stipulated separately.

**(Steering Committee)**

ARTICLE 7:

The Steering Committee for the Joint Usage/Research Center for Radiation Disaster Medical Science (hereinafter referred to as the "STEERING COMMITTEE") will be established in the RESEARCH CENTER to work in consultation with the Director of the Center Headquarters.

2. Items necessary for the STEERING COMMITTEE will be stipulated separately.

**(Sections)**

ARTICLE 8:

The following sections shall be established in the RESEARCH CENTER:

- (1) Joint Research Theme Review Section;
- (2) International Symposium Section;
- (3) Public Relations Section;
- (4) Assessment Section.

2. Items necessary for the sections will be stipulated separately.

**(Secretariat)**

ARTICLE 9:

The Secretariat for the RESEACH CENTER will be established in the Kasumi Campus Management Support Office at Hiroshima University.

**(Miscellaneous Provisions)**

ARTICLE 10:

In addition to the provisions set forth in these Internal Operational Regulations, the CENTER HEADQUARTERS COUNCIL will make provisions in relation to other necessary items with regard to the RESEARCH CENTER.

**Supplementary Provision**

The Internal Operational Regulations shall come into force as of April 1, 2016.

**Supplementary Provision**

Internal Operational Regulations shall come into force as of April 12, 2016, will be applicable as of April 1, 2016.
