Center Headquarters Council Bylaws of the Joint Use/Research Center for Radiation Disaster Medical Science

(Intent)

ARTICLE 1:

These Bylaws stipulate the necessary items with regard to the Center Headquarters Council of the Internal Operational Regulations of the Joint Usage/Research Center for Radiation Disaster Medical Science (hereinafter referred to as the “Center Headquarters COUNCIL”) pursuant to the provisions of Article 6, Paragraph 2 (established February 17, 2016) of the Internal Operational Regulations of the Joint Usage/Research Center for Radiation Disaster Medical Science.

(Organization)

ARTICLE 2:

The Center Headquarters COUNCIL shall be composed of the following members:

- (1) Head of the Research Institute for Radiation Biology and Medicine at Hiroshima University (Director of the Center Headquarters);
- (2) Head of the Atomic Bomb Disease Institute at Nagasaki University (Deputy Director of the Center Headquarters);
- (3) Head of the Fukushima Global Medical Science Center at Fukushima Medical University (Deputy Director of the Center Headquarters);
- (4) Two professors recommended by each research institute and the Center (including specially-appointed teaching staff).

2. The Director of the Center Headquarters shall commission the council members referred to in the preceding Item 4.

3. The term of appointment of the council members referred to in Paragraph 1, Item 4, shall be two years, and the usual practice shall be that they be commissioned on April 1. However, in the event they are commissioned on or after April 2, their final day shall be the last day of the fiscal year in which one year from the day of their commission falls.

4. There shall be nothing to preclude the reappointment of the committee members referred to in the preceding Paragraph 1, Item 4.

(Deliberation Items)

ARTICLE 3:

The Center Headquarters COUNCIL shall deliberate on the following items:

- (1) Matters relating to basic policies of the RESEARCH CENTER;
- (2) Other important matters relating to the operation of the RESEARCH CENTER.

(Meetings)

ARTICLE 4:

The Council Director and Deputy Director shall be appointed for the CENTER HEADQUARTERS COUNCIL.

2. The Director of the Center Headquarters shall serve as the Council Director.

3. The Deputy Director of the Council shall serve as the Deputy Director of the Center Headquarters.

4. The Council Director of the Council shall convene meetings of the CENTER HEADQUARTERS COUNCIL and act as its Chairman.

5. In the event the Director of the Council becomes incapacitated, the Deputy Director of the Council shall take over his/her duties and act in their stead.

(Hearing of Opinions)

ARTICLE 5:

When deemed necessary, the CENTER HEADQUARTER COUNCIL may call for persons other than council members to attend meetings and hear their opinions.

(Administrative Work)

ARTICLE 6:

The administrative work of the Center Headquarters COUNCIL shall be conducted at the Kasumi Campus Management Support Office at Hiroshima University.

(Miscellaneous Provisions)

ARTICLE 7:

Other items not stipulated in these Bylaws necessary with regard to the CENTER HEADQUARTERS COUNCIL shall be decided upon by the CENTER HEADQUARTERS COUNCIL.

Supplementary Provision

These Bylaws shall come into force as of April 1, 2016.

Supplementary Provision

These Bylaws shall come into force as of April 12, 2016, and will be applicable as of April 1, 2016.

Supplementary Provision

These Bylaws shall come into force as of June 9, 2017.
